Secondly, a "night out at the movies" can be cost-prohibitive for a working family. A couple with two children can easily spend \$75.00 to see one movie with "refreshments" sold in theatres, made up of high priced junk-food, reflecting a "mark-up" over cost that would be unheard of anywhere, except where there is—as here—a "captive audience", pun intended.

Thirdly, as if this wasn't enough, now movie theatres fill the big screen with paid advertisements, before the previews—another form of advertising revenue for the greedy theatrical landlord if not overlord.

Finally, music is part of man's soul, her spirit. It should not be prostituted. It should not be taxed. Music labels control and abuse the artists talent, while sucking them dry. They charge the people access to listen to music. Musicians should be free and unfettered to create. Music should be free. It has not been, but it is now. Enter: eWorldmedia and GoodGuysGuild (GGG)

"A" list film and T.V. actors, unlike stage-theatre performers (true artisans), are our country's counterpart to royalty, blue bloods, who are often just overpaid, spoiled and pampered—and one only needs look at the paparazzi and tabloid feeding frenzy geared to satiate the entertainment addiction. Simply stated, it is an industry manipulated by the few and powerful—the money-changers a/k/a executive producers, and the distributors and controllers of the media outlets a/k/a the studios, movie theaters and music labels. Their mission statement: make money for the "shareholders", pay "talent" the bare minimum, and let nepotism ride in the entertainment world, like a bull in a china shop. It's not

about who is the best and most talented, it is—and always has been—about "who you know." It is about greed married to stupidity and insensitivity.

THE SOLUTION: REVOLUTION

In the land of *Hollyweird* and music, we are not all bad, it's just that we are the minority, and the majority rules. That is about to change, because there is a new sheriff in town, and we ARE eWorld and ""Hollywood4Humanity"." And what we propose to do is give the gift of the entertainment industry back to the people, where it belongs. It is a simple task, really. We are going to take over Hollywood and the music labels. To entertain us, what matters is not the height of one's stardom, but rather the level of their craft and the depth and passion of their performance. Don't believe me? Okay. Believe Gabourey Sidibe.

Fourthly, we will pay all creative talent what they are worth, and not based on the A-D list they are on, at any given time in their career. Was Mickey Rourke worth near guild minimums when he did "The Wrestler", millions for a film today?

No longer, for example, will a working actor, model and musician have to wait on tables between projects and gigs, while a less talented "A" list actor makes 20M a film, or a model, dancer or musician gets paid \$150 a day for their work. Haven't you seen that actor walking down the red carpet, in a worst dressed tux and chewing gum—hey, it happens all the time. Hollywood does not value breeding and manners.

In our eWorld and GGG, all actors, models, musicians and other creative talent will be treated as equals, unless they are not.

Finally, brick and mortar is a dinosaur. There is no need for movie theaters as a method to deliver film to the people. Today, cable and network T.V., and their deafening stream of commercials, is yesterday's a beta or VHS tape. They both belong in museums, not sucking on the tit of the people, as cash cows for Hollywood's elite.

In GGG and eWorld, there is no caste system. We cast off the chains of bondage, in the name of the Internet. We can stream film, T.V. and music right into the home theater of the people.
